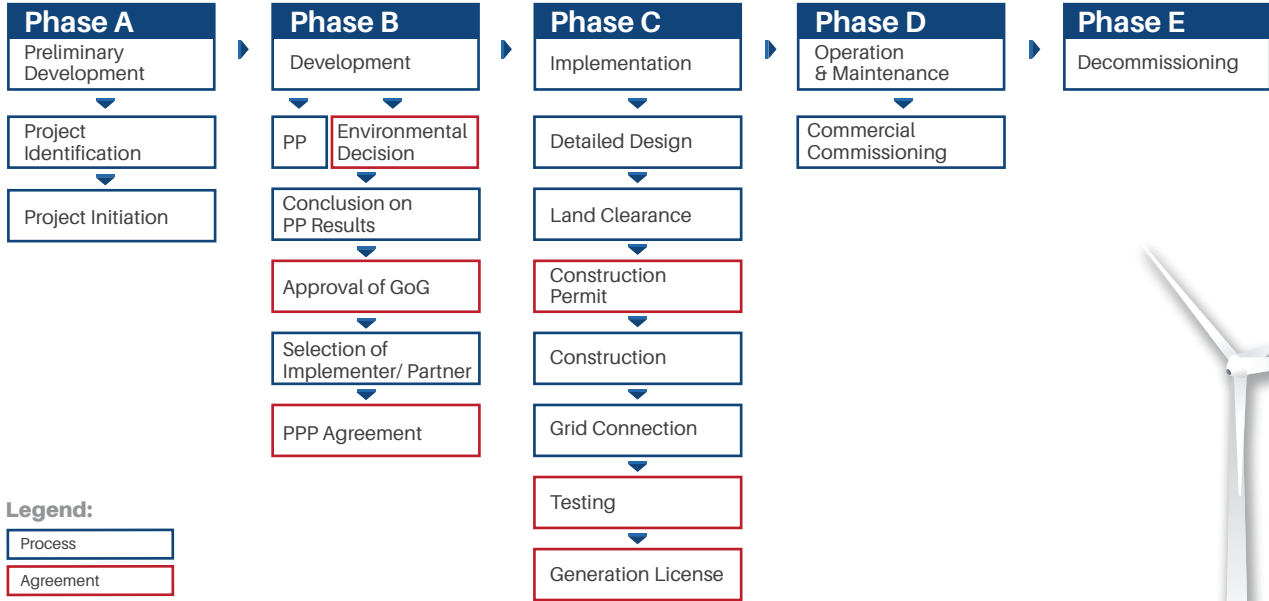
The Guidebook is intended to assist developers to navigate through the national requirements for the development of Variable Renewable Energy (VRE) projects.

For the purposes of the project VRE in the Guidebook includes Wind, Solar, Waste, Biofuel sources and excludes hydropower.

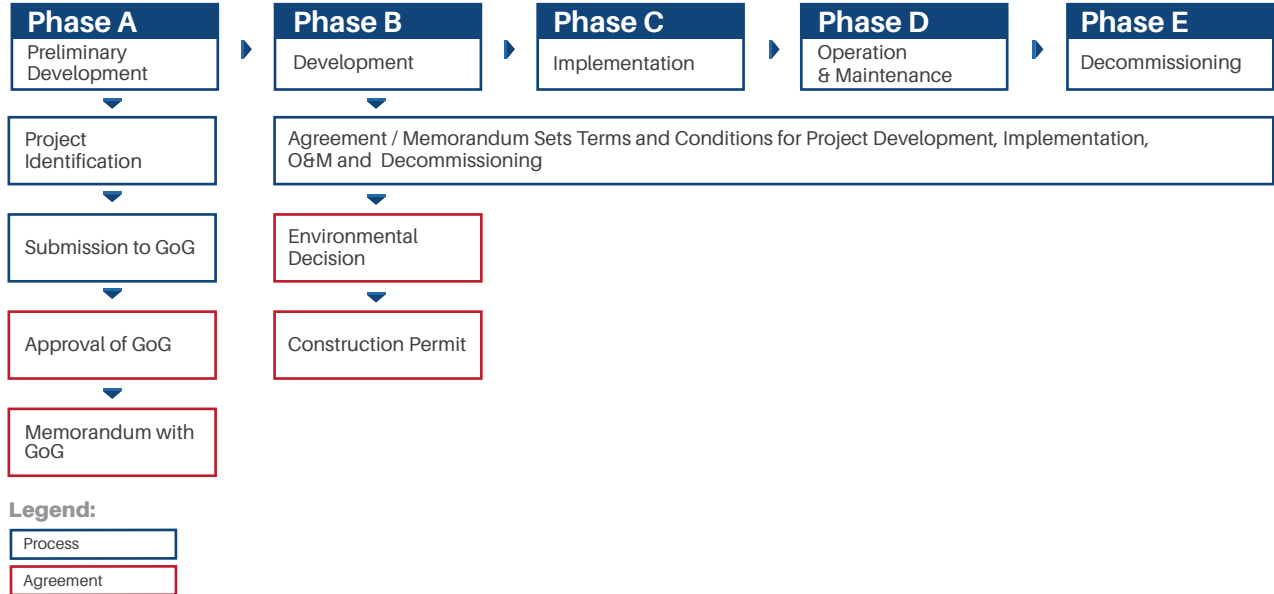
The Guidebook details on: basic description of each stage, requirements, timelines, validity, responsibilities and fees.



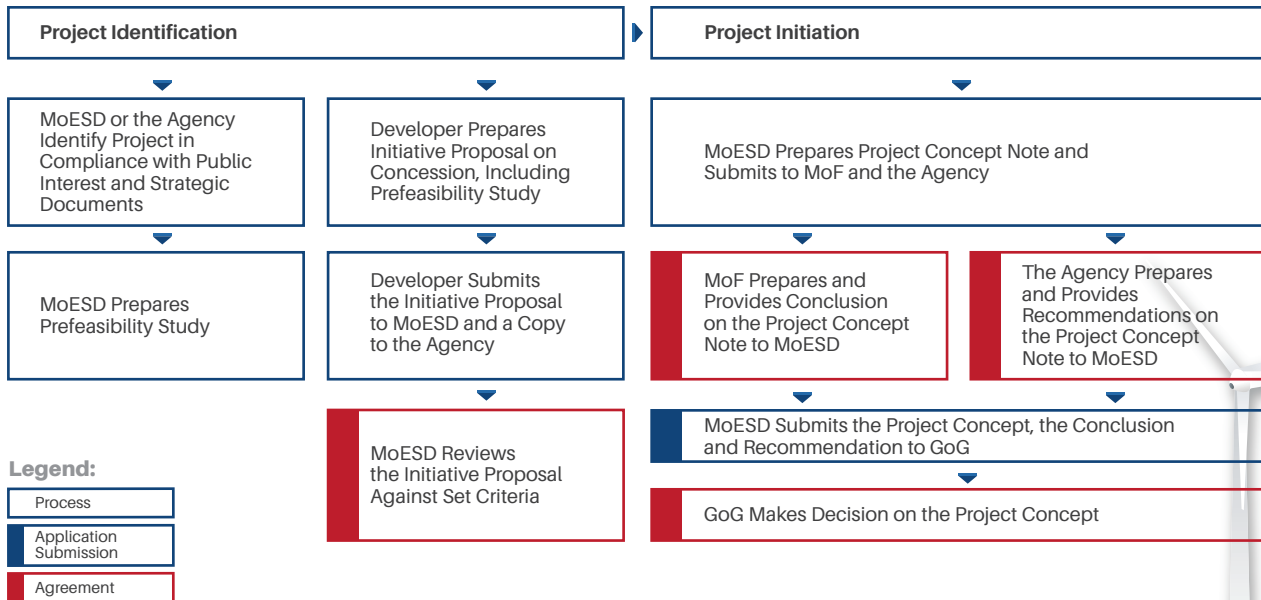
PROJECT DEVELOPMENT PHASES



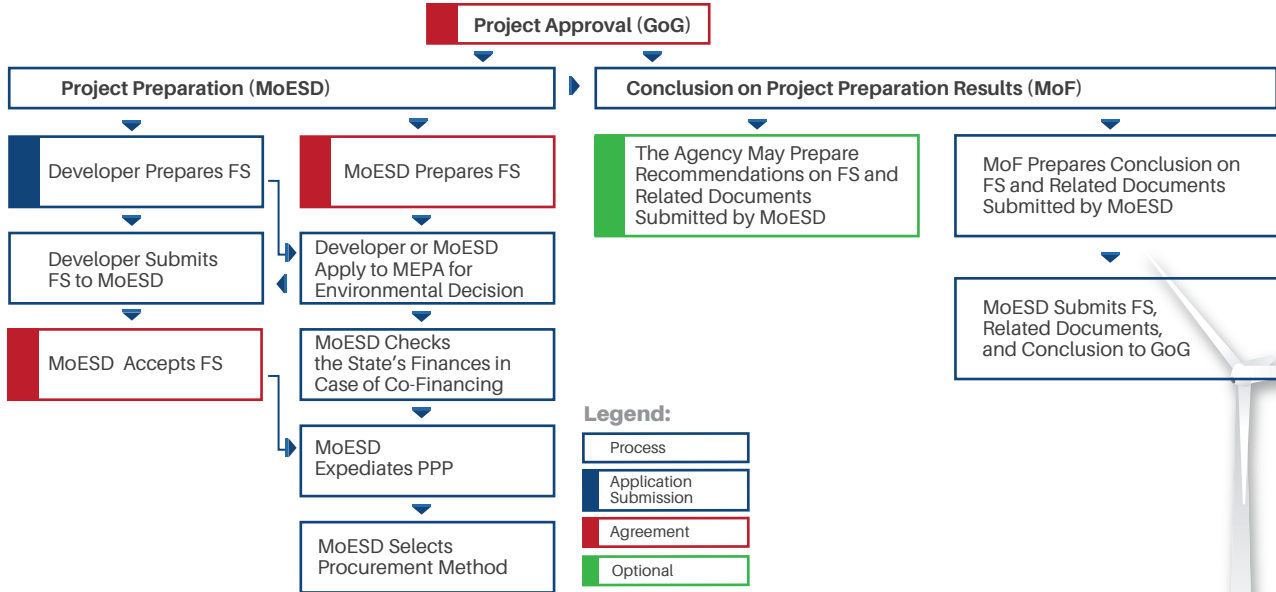
PROJECT DEVELOPMENT UNDER BOO LEGISLATION



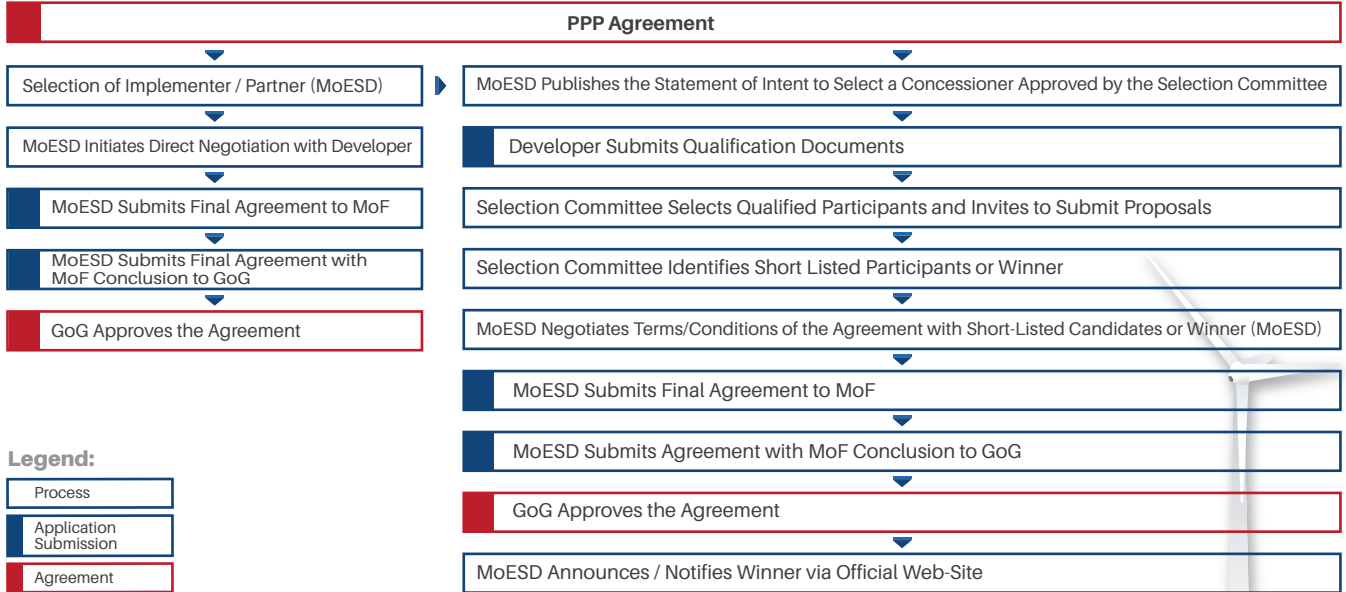
PHASE A - PROJECT PRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT



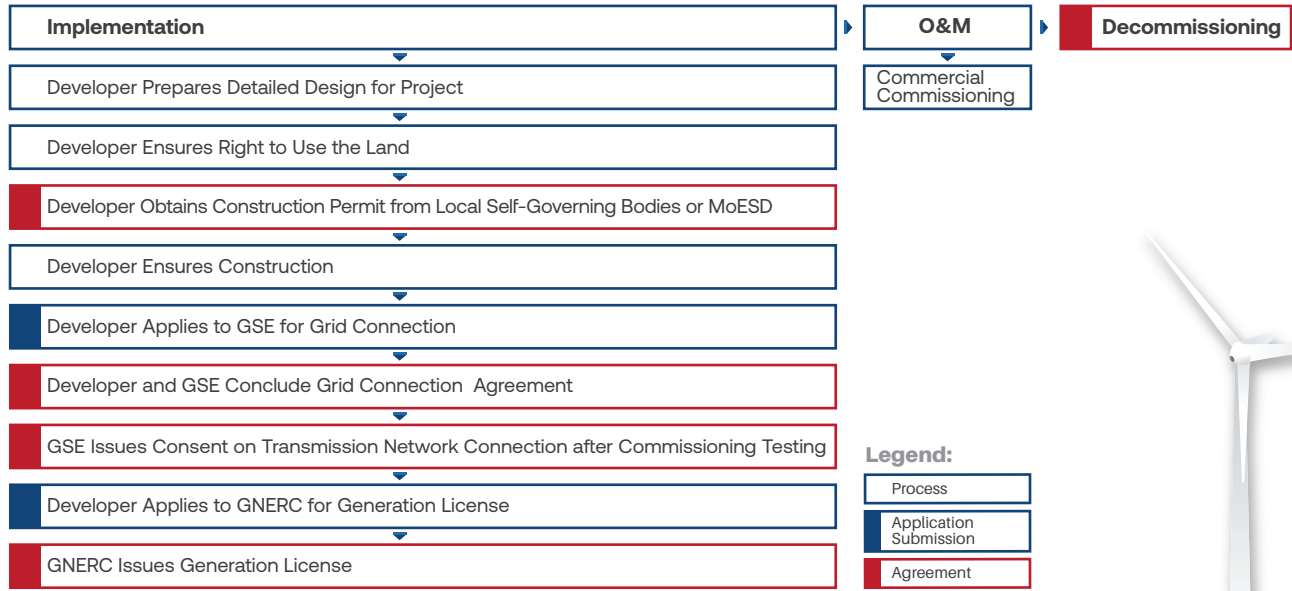
PHASE B - PROJECT DEVELOPMENT



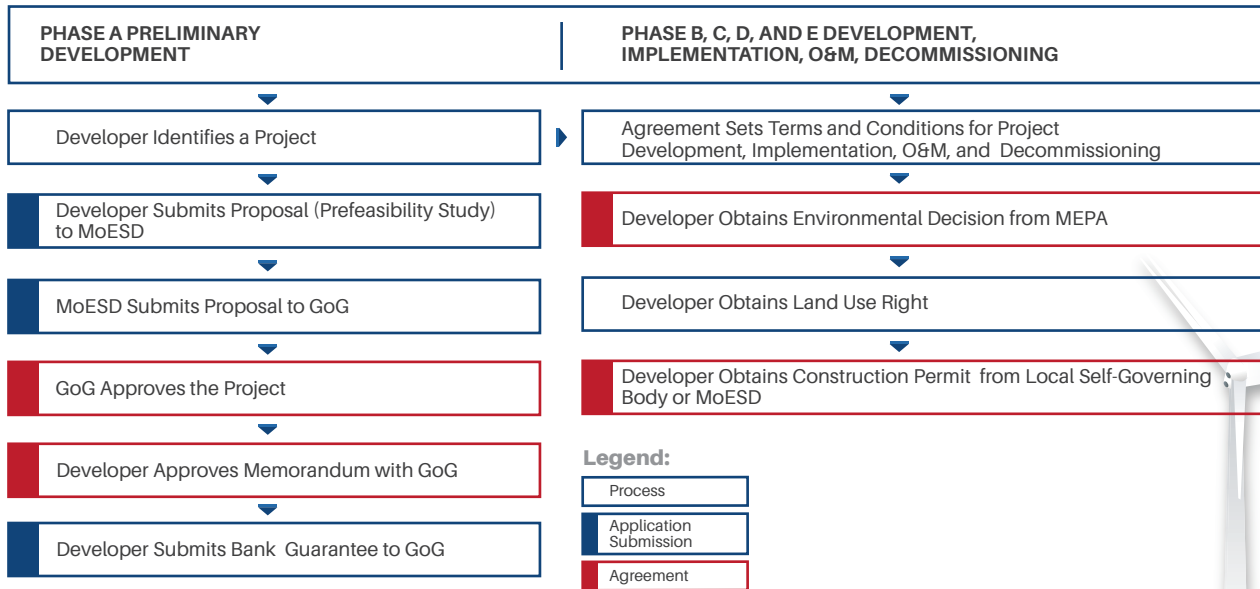
